Holland & Holland Bursary Application Form

Purpose

The purpose of the Holland & Holland bursary is to provide young and trainee gamekeepers and stalkers with the opportunity to pursue further study or projects related to conservation and game management.

Awards

An award or awards of up to £10,000 will be granted to the winning applicant(s). Awards are for one year only. All scholarship awards will be paid directly to the recipients.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be UK citizens
2. Applicants must be 18 years old or above.
3. Applicants must either be in their final year of a gamekeeping course or in the first five years of their gamekeeping career.

Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated commitment to gamekeeping or stalking, wildlife management and conservation
2. Completed application form
3. Letter of recommendation (see below for full requirements)

Application Requirements

To be considered for a bursary, applicants must complete an application and return it to Holland & Holland by Friday, 31st May. The application must include:

1. A completed application form.
2. A letter of recommendation. If you are still at college, this should be from your teacher or school official.
3. If shortlisted, you will be invited to interview in June. Travel expenses will be reimbursed upon proof of receipt.

Terms and Conditions

The Holland & Holland Bursary is awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, age, national origin or sexual orientation. Holland & Holland will not award scholarships to applicants who are not qualified and reserves the right not to award a scholarship in a given year.

1. The prize award can only be used to cover the direct costs of the proposal approved by Holland & Holland and for no other purpose.
2. The winner will have confirmed and secured their funded journey or course before 31st December 2019.
3. Applicants should be over 18 years of age and should not be classed as ‘minors’ in the proposed country of study or travel at the time they apply.
4. Holland & Holland will pay the grant award to the winner directly. Holland & Holland may ask for proof of appropriate spend to be provided by the winner in addition to the budget proposal outlined in the application form.
5. The winner is responsible for making all study, travel, and accommodation applications and arrangements in respect of the proposal. The winner will ensure that he or she has appropriate travel insurance in place if they are travelling abroad. For the avoidance of doubt, the cost of the insurance should be budgeted for as part of the prize application.
6. Holland & Holland does not grant any warranty as to the suitability or safety of the final proposal and shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by the winner other than in respect of any loss or damage arising from the negligence of Holland & Holland.
7. Shortlisted applicants may be asked to provide a full risk assessment for their proposed activity. The winner(s) will be required to provide evidence that their institution or current employer supports the proposed activities, including sign off for the risk assessment for the trip, should this be required.
8. On completion of their project, the winner will provide a full report to Holland & Holland of the journey and their key experiences and learning relevant to the award and the shooting community.
9. The winner agrees to undertake promotional activities at the request of Holland & Holland. The winner agrees to Holland & Holland publicising the award and agrees to co-ordinating with Holland & Holland on promotional activities and shall receive no additional fee for such publicity.
10. In the event that the winner does not confirm and secure their project by 31st December date, the winner will repay to Holland & Holland the full amount of the prize already paid.
11. In the event that the winner is in material breach of any of the terms contained herein and does not remedy the breach within 30 days of being notified of the breach by Holland & Holland, Holland & Holland reserves their right to terminate the bursary and the winner will repay to Holland & Holland the full amount of the prize already paid.
